## LAND RECLAMATION

100. Shri Bishwa Nath Roy: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

(a) the acreage of land reclaimed in India since 1947; and

(b) the target of reclaiming land in 1953-54 by the Central Tractors Organisation?

The Minister of Food and Agriculture (Shri Kidwai): (a) During the six years beginning with the 1947-48 reclamation season the Central Tractor Organisation has reclaimed a total area of 9.83,797 acres in Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Madhya Bharat, Bhopal and Punjab; while an additional acreage of 17,62,186 has been reclaimed by the States with the help of their own tractors.

(b) The targets for reclamation during the 1953-54 reclamation season are (i) clearance of 2,47,500 acres of Kans-infested lands, and (ii) 8,000 acres of jungle clearance.
