Tea Centre in Edinburgh

3450. Shri P. C. Borooah: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have decided to set up a Tea Centre in Edinburgh:
 - (b) if so, at what cost; and
- (c) the salient features of this Centre?

The Minister of International Trade in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Shri Manubhai Shah): (a) Government have approved the proposal of the Tea Board to set up a Tea Centre in Edinburgh.

- (b) The capital cost of the project is estimated at £30,000.
- (c) The entire decor of the Tea Centre will be Indian in character. The Centre is being set up to project the image of Indian Tea in Scotland and it will form part of the overall promotional campaign for Indian tea there.

Opening of a Tea Centre by the Irish Tea Council

- (a) whether a proposal to open a Tea Centre by the Irish Tea Council in collaboration with the Indian Tea Board has been under consideration; and
- (b) if so, Government's decision in the matter?

The Minister of International Trade in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (Shri Manubhai Shah): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Government have approved of the proposal.

Industrial Estates in Orissa

(b) 1 Estate has gone into production, 4 Estates have been completed and a few units in 2 of these Estates have started functioning. The construction work in 3 other Estates is in progress and is expected to be completed shortly.
