The Minister of State in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri Datar):
(a) 7 persons, including Rakesh Dhar (not Paresh Ranjan Dhev) and Bimal Dey not Bimal Dev), who were proceeding on the Silchar-Haflong road in a truck and a jeep were kidnapped by a gang of 200 Naga hostiles near Dalia P.W.D. gate on the evening of the 24th April, 1962. Nothing was taken from them. All these persons were subsequently released by the hostiles on the 27th April.

## Thefts in M.P.s' Flats

1839. Shri Jedhe: Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are aware that thefts have been taking place during session and inter-session periods in the North and South Avenues of M.P.s' flats for a long time in New Delhi;
- (b) if so, what steps have been taken to stop these thefts uptil now;
- (c) how many M.P.'s have suffered by thse thefts during last five years;
- (d) what is the cost of the property stolen by thieves in the last 5 years with names of M.P.s; and
- (e) what action Governent propose to take regarding the protection of their properties in the flats in their absence?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri Datar):
(a) Government are aware of the position.

(b), (d) and (e): Two statements containing the requisite information

- are laid on the Table of the House [See Appendix III, annexures No. 6 and 7].
- (c) 55 members of Parliament have suffered from these thefts and burglaries from 1957 to 1961.

## National Academy of Administration, Mussoorie

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is a proposal to shift the National Academy of Administration from Mussoorie (U.P.) to some other place;
  - (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) where this institution is going to be shifted to, and when?

The Minister of Home Affairs (Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri): (a) to (c). The question whether the National Academy of Administration should be shifted from Mussoorie and if so, to what place, is under consideration of the Government.

## Widows of Deceased Central Government Employees

- 1841. Shri D. C. Sharma: Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that a number of widows of deceased Central Government employees, without means of livelihood, have sought employment assistance;
- (b) if so, the nature of assistance being rendered; and
- (c) whether there is any proposal to relax the rules and conditions of employment like registration with the Employment Exchange or educational qualifications etc. so that certain impediments in the matter of employment are removed?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri Datar):
