Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the main aims and objectives of the Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED);
- (b) whether TRIFED has achieved its laid down aims and objectives;
- (c) the number of products sold under TRIFED in the last five years, State-wise details thereof;
- (d) the number of self-help groups formed by TRIFED and the number of sensitization programs undertaken by TRIFED, in the last five years; and
- (e) the details of Minimum Support Price (MSP) for various Minor Forest Produce (MFP)?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED) was established with the objective of bringing about socio-economic development of tribal communities by way of promoting the marketing of the tribal products on which their lives depend. To achieve these objectives TRIFED has empaneled 3069 suppliers / producers for procurement of various tribal products and realized significant sales through 'TribesIndia' outlets and ecommerce platforms. TRIFED normally procures and sells products of various categories like metal craft, textile, jewellery, painting, cane & bamboo, terracotta & pottery, organic & natural food products etc. The details of the number of such products sold during the last five years, State-wise, is given at **Annexure 1**.

(d): So far, TRIFED has sanctioned 3,958 Van Dhan Vikas Kendras (VDVKs) comprising of around 59,000 SHGs and involving 11.83 lakh beneficiaries, out of which training for value addition related activities has been conducted in 1,888 VDVks.

(e): The details of 87 Minor Forest Produce (MFP) for which Minimum Support Price (MSP) has been notified is given as **Annexure 2**.
