Will the Minister of **AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH)** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Government Yoga and Naturopathy Research Institutes presently functioning in the country, State/ UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government is planning to establish more Yoga and Naturopathy Research Institutes in different parts of the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise including UP and Kerala; and
- (d) the other measures being taken by the Government to promote research work on yoga and naturopathy?

ANSWER

(a): Presently the Central Council for Research in Yoga & Naturopathy (CCRYN) is running 01 Central Research Institute of Yoga & Naturopathy at Rohini, Delhi.

In addition to this National Institute of Naturopathy (NIN), has established a Research Desk to look into institutional research and collaborative studies.

(b) & (c): Yes, the details are given at Annexure.

(d): The CCRYN is taking following measures to promote research work on Yoga & Naturopathy in the country: -

1. Establishment of *Institutes of Yoga and Naturopathy Research* with 200 bedded *Yoga and Naturopathy hospital* at Jhajjar, Haryana and Nagmangala, Karnataka.

2. Establishment of Central Research Institutes of Yoga & Naturopathy in different States of the country along with 100 bedded indoor hospital facilities to carry out in depth research studies to establish the efficacy of Yoga and Naturopathy in various remedies.

3. Collaborative Research Centre to verify the efficacy of Yoga & Naturopathy in various diseases.

Establishment of Yoga and Naturopathy OPDs: The Council is already running 7 Yoga and Naturopathy OPDs in Govt. Hospital of Delhi and Haryana. It has opened 6 new OPDs in Odisha, Tripura, Kerala, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh.

Establishment of Institutes of Yoga and Naturopathy Research :

KARNATAKA

- (i) Institute of Yoga and Naturopathy Research, Nagamangala, Karnataka: First phase of construction work on 15 acres of cost free land provided by Govt. of Karnataka has been completed. The construction work of 2nd phase has been assigned to M/s NPCC and construction work has already commenced. A sum of Rs.12.65 crores has been released for this purpose.

HARYANA

- (ii) Institute of Yoga and Naturopathy Research, Devarkhana, Jhajjar, Bahadurgarh, Haryana: First phase of construction work on 10 acres of cost free land provided by Govt. of Haryana has been completed. The construction work of 2nd phase has been assigned to M/s NPCC and construction work has already commenced. In the meantime, 10 acres of additional land has been provided by Govt. of Haryana on free of cost basis adjacent to the existing land around for Post Graduate Institute. A sum of Rs.14.00 crores has been released for this purpose.

ODISHA

- (iii) Central Research Institute of Yoga & Naturopathy (CRIYN), Bhubaneswar, Odisha: 20 acre premium free land has been registered in the name of the Council and funds to the tune of Rs.157.88 lakhs have been released to the CPWD, Nayapalli, Bhubaneswar for construction of boundary wall, walking track etc. Demarcation of the allotted land has been completed in July, 2016. However, construction work could not be commenced due to resistance of the villagers.

DELHI

- (iv) Central Research Institute of Yoga & Naturopathy (CRIYN), Rohini, Delhi: Indoor Hospital has been started functioning from 27th April, 2016. Yoga & Naturopathy treatments are being provided both under IPD and OPD for the benefit of common people.

WEST BENGAL

- (v) Central Research Institute of Yoga & Naturopathy (CRIYN), West Bengal: In principle' approval of Hon'ble HFM Government of India for setting up of a CRI including 100 bedded hospital of Yoga & Naturopathy has been obtained and conveyed to Government of West Bengal. Formal transfer of land in the name of CCRYN by Govt. of West Bengal is awaited.

RAJASTHAN

- (vi) Central Research Institute of Yoga & Naturopathy (CRIYN), Jaipur, Rajasthan: The Government of Rajasthan has offered 13.5 acres premium free land for establishment of CRI including 100 bedded hospital of Yoga & Naturopathy. Approval of competent authority is conveyed to the Govt. of Rajasthan. Formal transfer of land in the name of CCRYN by Govt. of Rajasthan is awaited.

ANDHRA PRADESH

- (vii) Central Research Institute of Yoga & Naturopathy (CRIYN), Vijaywada, Andhra Pradesh: The Government of Andhra Pradesh has offered 25 acres cost free land for establishment of CRIY&N including 100 bedded hospital of Yoga & Naturopathy at Vijaywada, Andhra Pradesh. Approval of competent authority is conveyed to the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh. Formal transfer of land in the name of CCRYN by Govt. of Andhra Pradesh is awaited.
