FOURTH REPORT

(Fourth Lok Sabha)

The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Monday, the 10th July, 1967.

2. The Committee recommend that—

- (a) in order to provide extra time for discussion of the Demands for Grants in respect of Budget (General) for 1967-68, the House might sit also on Saturdays, the 15th and the 22nd July, 1967;
- (b) discussion and voting on the Demands for Grants should conclude by 6 P.M. on Saturday, the 22nd July, 1967; and
- (c) after disposal of the Demands for Grants of the Ministry of Health & Family Planning, priority may be given to the Demands for Grants of the following Ministries:—
 - (i) Education
 - (ii) Petroleum & Chemicals
 - (iii) Steel, Mines & Metals.
