- (a) Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying has not made any assessment regarding demand and supply of milk in North Eastern States of the country including Assam. However, a study on current and future demand of milk and milk products in the country including North Eastern States has been commissioned by National Dairy Development Board under National Dairy Plan- I. The major findings of this study are expected to be available by November 2019.

- (c) The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing “Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme” to promote dairy farming in North Eastern States including Assam.
