

Drinking Water Project in Bihar

129. SHRI TEJ NARAYAN SINGH: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) the annual outlay for drinking water project in Bihar during the years 1989-90 and 1990-91;

(b) the amount spent on this project during this year; and

(c) the present position regarding its completion and the steps being taken by the Government to expedite the work?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI RAM BAHADUR SINGH): (a) Allocation for the years 1989-90 and 1990-91 are as under:-

(b) Expenditure during 1990-91 under Centrally Sponsored Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme/Mini-Mission and Minimum Need Programme is Rs. 9.83 Crores and Rs. 8.90 Crores respectively upto October, 1990.

(c) All 44 'no source problem villages (PVs) will be covered (18 PVs have been covered upto October, 1990) with safe drinking water facilities by 31.3.1991. All the partially covered villages are likely to be fully covered with safe drinking water facilities in first two years of VIII Plan i. e by 31.3.1992.

Declaration of roads as National Highways in Andhra Pradesh

(a) the details of the proposals pending with the Union Government for declaration of important State roads as National Highways in Andhra Pradesh; and

(b) the time by which a decision is likely to be taken thereon?

THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES AND MINISTER OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI MANUBHAI KOTADIA): (a) The list of roads furnished by the Government of Andhra Pradesh from time to time for inclusion in the National Highway grid is enclosed as a Statement.

(b) It is too early to indicate the time by which decision to include or otherwise these roads in the National Highway grid will be taken as the size of Eighth Five Year Plan has not yet been decided.
