Waiting list for Transfer/Shifting of Telephone Connections in Delhi

198. SHRI P.M. SAYEED: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) the number of applications on the waiting list for transfer/shifting of telephone connections in Delhi;

(b) the reasons for delay in transfer case; and

(c) the time by which the telephone connections are likely to be transferred in above cases?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI JAI PARKASH): (a) As on 15.12.90 the number of applications for transfer/shifting of telephones to different exchanges in Delhi on

the waiting list was 1904.

(b) The main reasons for pending shift cases are the constraints of adequate exchange capacities and lack of spare cable parts in certain cases.

(c) All pending transfer cases are likely to be cleared in a year's time.
