Setting up Post Office in Lohandwala Complex, Andheri (W), Bombay

211. SHRIMATI JAYAWANTI NAVINCHANDRA MEHTA: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is no local Post Office at Lokhandwala Complex, Andheri (W) in Western Bombay;

(b) if so, whether the Government have received any representation for setting up a Post Office there and if so, what action the Government are contemplating in this regard; and

(c) whether the Postal Department has taken any action to augment the delivery staff?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE

MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI JAI PARKASH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Postmaster General Bombay has since approved the opening of a delivery Post Office in Lokhandwala Complex. It will be opened as soon as suitable accommodation is available.

(c) Sanction of staff involves time consuming procedure due to restriction on creation of posts imposed by the Government. Pending comprehensive review of staff requirements, the following posts have since been sanctioned for Andheri Railway Station Post Office which serves Lokhandwala Complex area:
