Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether some foreign companies have offered to manufacture VCRs and VCPs in India;

(b) if so, the names of such companies; and

(c) the action taken by Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (PROF. M.G.K. MENON): (a) to (c). No offer has been received directly from any foreign company to manufacture VCRs/VCPs in India. However, the following three Private sector companies have been given approval for manufacture of VCRs/VCPs in technical & financial collaboration with foreign companies:

(a) whether there is any UGC scheme for coaching minority students to enable them to compete on equal terms for various competitive and entrance examinations;

(b) the names of Universities/Colleges which are participating in the UGC scheme

of coaching students belonging to minority communities;

(c) whether the gains and achievements of the Scheme have been reviewed;

(d) the number of students coached during the last three years, year-wise and examination-wise and the expenditure incurred thereon; and

(e) the number of students coached who were successful in the examination for which they were coached during the last three years, year-wise and examination-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The names of Universities/Colleges participating in the UGC Scheme of coaching students belonging to minority communities is given in Statement-1.

(c) UGC appointed a Committee in 1986 to assess the implementation of the Scheme of coaching classes for minorities and suggest measures for its effective implementation. The Committee recommended to restructure the scheme so as to have Regional Resource Centres for preparation of textual materials, provision for library facilities and a forum for group discussion. It also recommended for training for coordinators and wider publicity to the Scheme.
