(c) the details of schemes drawn up for rehabilitation of the displaced persons?

THE MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI NILAMANI ROURAY): (a) Data on forest land and population affected, as reported by the project authorities, is given below:

(c) and (d). There is only one Central public sector undertaking, viz. NTC (Tamilnadu & Pondicherry) Ltd., having its registered office in the State of Tamilnadu which has incurred a net loss of Rs. 9.53 crores during the year 1988-89.
