- (a) whether attention of the Government has been drawn to the news-item appearing in Decan Herald dated 11 July, 1990 under the Caption "Tehri Project to be ready by 1996.
- (b) whether the noted Environmentalist
  Shri Sunder Lal Bahuguna led a movement
  against the Coffer Dam and called for lowering its height; and
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor and the reaction of the Government thereto?

THE MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI NILAMANI ROUTRAY): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c). Yes, Sir.

Shri Sunder Lal Bahuguna and the local people have been agitating against the construction of a 260.5 m high Tehri Dam because of apprehensions regarding its safety and likely environmental destruction in the area. The Government have setup a High level Committee of Experts to examine the safety aspects of the Tehri Dam.

## Reservation of Seats in Professional Courses

4087. SHRI JOSS FERNANDEZ: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Karnataka Government has reserved some percentage of seats in Engineering and Diploma Courses for Anglo-Indian community students;
- (b) if so, whether such reservation is in vogue in other states; and
- (c) if not, whether Government propose to direct all the State Government to make reservations in professional courses like engineering and diploma courses to Anglo-Indian community students?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DE-VELOPMENT (SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA): (a) Yes, Sir, the Karnataka Government has reserved one seat for B.E. Degree course at the University Visvesvaraya College of Engineering, Bangalore.

- (b) Yes, Sir, one seat is reserved in Polytechnics in Tamil Nadu.
- (c) There is no such proposal under consideration of the Government.

Financial assistance to Youth Organisations in U.P.

- (a) the number of youth voluntary organisations in Uttar Pradesh which receive financial assistance from the Union Government:

  - (d) if so, the outcome thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DE-VELOPMENT (SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA): (a) 266 youth voluntary organisations in Uttar Pradesh received financial assistance from the Department of Youth Affairs and Sports during the last three years.
