Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) the provision regarding promotion of PGTs belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe category to the post of Vice Principal and that of Vice-Principals to the post of Principals in Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan;

(b) the number of PGTs, General as well as Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe promoted to the posts of Vice-Principals and Vice-Principals to the post of Principals since 1988; and

(c) whether there is any back-log of any kind with regard to the promotion of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA): (a) 15% and 7 1/2% posts both for Vice-Principals and Principals are reserved for promotion for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe, respectively.

(b) 1) 135 Post Graduate Teachers of general category and 2 Scheduled Caste have been promoted as Vice-Principals, since 1988.

2) 43 Vice-Principals of general category have been promoted as Principals, since 1988. No Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Vice-Principal has been promoted as Principal, since 1988.

(c) No, Sir, as Government of India's instructions do not provide for carry forward of vacancies in the case of posts to be filled by promotion by the selection method.
