Shri Morarji Desai: Nobody has asked for any assistance so far, for those families, and any information that was sought to be obtained has not resulted in any positive thing.

Shri Hem Barua: In view of the fact that the goldsmiths in this country, about five lakhs of them according to our Finance Minister, are faced with the bleak prospect of starvation, may I know whether Government serously tried to foresee the gravity of the situation, and if they did, why is it that they did not take adequate measures to neutralise the gravity of the situation, because the measures that are spoken of up till now are only in the formative stage?

Mr. Speaker: The hon. Member is only entering into an argument.

Shri Hem Barua: I asked what steps had been taken.

Mr. Speaker: I said that the hon. Member was only entering into an argument.

Shri Hem Barua: No, Sir. I do not know how it is a question of entering into an argument....

Mr. Speaker: Now, he wants me to give arguments. My arguments might not be convincing to him. What would happen in that case? Then too, this would remain the decision. So, why enter into an argument?

Will the Minister of Irrigation and Power be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that U.N. Special Fund has sent an expert from Sweden, to serve for two years as an adviser on river basin surveys and hydro-electric projects in India;

(b) whether it is also a fact that he will go into the requirements of third and fourth Plans; and

(c) what other kind of assistance U.N. Special Fund is going to extend in this matter?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Irrigation and Power (Shri S. A. Mehdi): (a) Yes, Sir. A Swedish Engineer has been appointed for a period of 2 years by the U.N. Special Fund as their Resident Adviser in conriection with their aid programme for investigation of sites for the generation of hydro-power in the country.

(b) No, Sir.

(c) The assistance to be extended by the U.N. Special Fund in this connection will be in respect of the supply of equipment and precision instruments etc and also services of concultants.

श्वी सै॰ ग्र॰ मेंह्वी : ग्रभी तो ये स्कीमें इनवैस्टीगेट की जा रही है ग्रौर जैसा मैं ने कहा करीब ६२ स्कीमें हैं । ये तमाम मुल्क में हैं ग्रौर इनकी तफसील ग्रगर ग्राप चाहें तो मैं दे सकता हूं । यह जो उनकी तरफ से ग्रादमी ग्राया है यह स्वीडिश इंजीनियर है ग्रौर उन्होंने ग्रपनी तरफ से कुछ बातें दरियाफ्त करने के लिए, पहले इनवैस्टीगेशन करने के लिए, उससे कहा है ग्रौर कुछ इक्विपमेंट भेजा जा रहा है । इस ग्रादमी से वे मश्विरा लेंगे, ऐसा उन्होंने कहा है ।

Shri Maheswar Naik: May I know whether the foreign aid or colaboration which is likely to be available will be dependent upon the recommendation of the expert who is visiting our country from Sweden?

Shri S. A. Mehdi: At the moment, the total expenditure likely to be incurred on the resident adviser would be met by the UN, and the equipment will be sent free of cost.

Shri Maheswar Naik: My question has not been answered. I wanted to know whether any foreign aid or collaboration that was likely to be available would be dependent upon the recommendation of this expert?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Irrigation and Power (Shri Alagesan): It would not be dependent upon the recomendation of this expert. Here, it is purely assistance for investigation purposes, and certain instruments and equipment are being given by the UN Special Fund.

Shri Iqbal Singh: May I know whether we have in India similar experts like the foreign expert who is called? If so, what was the purpose of calling a foreign expert?

Shri Alagesan: This is only to help u_s in the procurement of special equipment and instruments. He will keep in touch with the State Electricity Boards in regard to the progress of investigations of various projects and try to help us in procuring these things. He will bulk all the requirements and place orders.

Shri Bhagwat Jha Azad: Will the recommendations of this foreign expert after investigation be followed up by any help from the UN Fund for implementing them or they will only be for the consideration of Government?

Shri Alagesan: We carry on the projects in the usual manner. This expert is only to look after procurement of special equipment and instruments needed for investigation purposes.

Shri P. Venkatasubbaiah: What are the terms of reference given to the expert? Will he give a comprehensive report on the potential of power and irrigation in the country or will he go into only such of those schemes as are taken up in the Third and Fourth Plans?

Shri Alagesan: He will not be doing any such comprehensive review.

Shri Alagesan: Various projects are being investigated by State agencies and some are investigated by the CWPC. House-building Loans

Will the Minister of Works, Housing and Rehabilitation be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is proposed to review the scheme of house-building loans to Government employees;

(b) whether any modifications in the rules have been made; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and the total amount of house-building loans granted to Government servants during 1962-63?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Works, Housing and Rehabilitation (Shri P. S. Naskar): (a) to (c). The grant of advances under the House Building Advance Rules was suspended in November, 1962, so as to keep the expenditure during 1962-63 within the budget provision of Rupees sixty lakhs. It has since been decided to entertain new applications from 1st April, 1963. Advances will, however, be given hereafter only to employees whose monthly pay does not exceed Rs. 1,250 and who have already acquired purchased plots of land. The maximum advance admissible to an applicant is twenty-four times his monthly pay and is subject to a maximum of Rs. 25,000.

During 1962-63, house-building Advances amounting to Rs. 93.51 lakhs were approved in the case of 710 Central Government servants.

Shri D. C. Sharma: Government servants who build houses of their own are asked to occupy those houses, leaving the government quarters. In how many cases has this rule been observed and in how many cases has this rule not been observed, and what are the reasons for not observing this rule?

The Minister of Works, Housing and Rehabilitation (Shri Mehr Chand
