#### Firing by Pakistani Troops

(a) whether it is a fact that Pakistani troops fired several thousand rounds with machine guns in the Mendhar Sector of Cease-fire line area in Jammu and Kashmir on the 12th September, 1964;

(b) if so, the number of persons injured or killed in the firing; and

(c) government's reaction thereto?

The Minister of Defence (Shri Y. B. Chavan): (a) On 12th September, 1964, there was heavy firing in the Mendhar sector. Pakistan troops fired with light machine guns and medium machine guns from across the ceasefire line on our posts in Mendhar area. The fire was returned in selfdefence.

(b) None.

(c) Cease-fire violation complaints were lodged with the U.N. Military Observers. Suitable precautionary measures have been taken on our side of the cease-fire line.
