The Minister of Planning (Shri Asoka Mehta): In discussions with the Planning Commission, the State Governments agreed to consider proposal for raising additional resources for the 1966-67 Plan through changes in urban immovable property tax or levy of such a tax in case the State Government concerned was not levying it already. The U.P. Government has since introduced changes in the urban immovable property tax levied in that State and the Guiarat Government has increased the education cess on lands and buildings in urban areas. The Bihar Government has also introduced a Bill in the State Legislature for imposing a tax on non-agricultural urban land. Besides, the Mysore Government has recently placed a Bill before the State Legislature for levying a tax on urban land and the Kerala Government is actively considering the matter. Information for other States is not yet available.
