The Government of India set up a Committee in May 1961, under the Chairmanship of Dr. Sampurnanand, to examine the role of education in promoting emotional integration in national life and to suggest suitable programmes in this regard. The final Report of the Committee is expected soon. Necessary steps, in so far as education is concerned, will be initiated on receipt of the Committee's Report.
