ORAL ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS

Rockefeller Grants to Indian Agriculture Research Institute, New Delhi

Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Rockefeller Foundation has recently announced some grants to Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi;
- (b) if so, how much and how it is to be spent.
- (c) what grants have been sanctioned to other recipient bodies in India for 1962-63; and
- (d) how they will have to be spent?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Finance (Shri B. R. Bhagat): (a) A grant was sanctioned by the Rockefeller Foundation to the Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi in October, 1961.

(a) The amount of the grant is \$45,000. It is to be utilized for import of such components of air-conditioning equipment, as are not indigenously available for the Library Wing and adjacent stock-rooms of the institute.

## STATEMENT

Reckefeller Foundation Grants Sanctioned during the year 1962-63,

Name of the Institute

University of Rajasthan,

Name of the Amount Purpose

For purchase of equipment and supplies for research in Zoology.

University of \$76,000 Lucknow For purchase of research equipment for the Department of Bio-Chemistry of the Science Faculty and for Department of Pharmacology in King Georges medical College.

University of \$37,800 Lucknow For meeting part of the construction cost of three experimental teaching Health Sub-Centres for fields teaching in social and preventive medicine in the K. G. medical College.

In addition, three travel grants have been sanctioned by the Rockefeller Foundation to three Research Scholars for study and research in pathology, biology and library science.

Shri Subodh Hansda: From the statement I find that two universities have been sanctioned grant by the Rockefeller Foundation. May I know the basis of selection of universities for giving grants?

Shri B. R. Bhagat: This particular grant was in pursuance of an agreement signed between the Government and the Rockefeller Foundation on development of post-degree courses in the Indian Agricultural Research Institute for which a sum of dollars was provided. Later on because of the rise in prices and other reasons, another grant of 45 000 dollars has been provided for the Library Wing. So far as the general question of giving grants is concerned. Rockefeller Foundation is interested general welfare activities like science. public health and education. As a result of discussions between the External Affairs Ministry and the representatives of the Rockefeller Foundation, subjects of mutual interest are agreed upon.

Shri Subodh Hansda: Since the Indian Agricultural Research Institute has been giving this additional grant of 45 000 dollars for importing the airconditioning equipment, may I know from which country the machinery will be imported?

Shri B. R. Bhagat: Since this is a free grant without any conditions attached to it, it will be imported from such country where the condition of the equipment and the prices are favourable.

Shri Heda: So far as the grant to I.A.R.T. is concerned may I know whether the Institute had applied for a small sum of 45,000 dollars?

Shri B. R. Bhagat: As I said this is part of the original agreement between the Government and the Rockefeller Foundation under which they gave 100.000 dollars for development of post-graduate courses in the ICAR, including the construction of a Library Wing. But for some reason or other, the Library Wing could not be started. In the meanwhile, the prices went up. So, this additional grant was given by them.

Shri B. K. Das: May I know whether any other institution has applied for

this grant and, if so, on what basis this selection was made?

Shri B. R. Bhagat: There is no other institution in the country like the Indian Agricultural Research Institute.

Shri S. M. Banerjee: It is mentioned in the statement:

"In addition, three travel grants have been sanctioned by the Rockefeller Foundation to three Research Scholars for study and research in pathology, biology and library science."

May I know how these grants have been distributed? Who are the scholars? What is the basis of their selection?
