(क) विभिन्न प्रकार के कारखानों के लिए प्रशिक्षित कर्मचारियों की आवश्यकताओं में बहुत अधिक फर्क होता है। ऐसी हालत में सभी बड़े कारखानों की तरह तरह की आवश्यकताएं पूरी करने के लिए एक ही व्यापक योजना बनाना संभव नहीं है। इसलिए बड़े बड़े कारखाने चालू करने में पहले कुशल और दक्ष कारीगरों के प्रशिक्षण की कोई सामान्य योजना नहीं बनायी गयी है। लेकिन हर एक कारखाने की योजना बनाते समय ऐसे सभी वर्गों के कर्मचारियों के प्रशिक्षण का काफी प्रबन्ध करना आवश्यक होता है जिनकी जरूरत कारखाना चालू हो जाने पर हुआ करती है। इसी लिए प्राविधिक सलाहकारों में किये गये कारारों में अनिवार्य रूप से यह तथ्य कर लिया जाता है कि वे हमारे कर्मचारियों को भारत में और अपने देश के कारखानों में प्रशिक्षण देने का इन्तजाम करेंगे।

(ख) जिन मामलों में सरकारी स्तर पर प्राविधिक सहयोग का प्रबन्ध किया जाता है, उन में सम्बन्धित विदेशी सरकार से प्रशिक्षण की सुविधाएं देने के बारे में बातचीत की जाती है। दूसरे मामलों में योजना से सम्बन्धित विदेशी सलाहकार फर्म से प्रशिक्षण का इन्तजाम करने के लिये बातचीत होती है।
