Tagore's Ancestral Home in Calcutta

*1414. **Shrimati Renu Chakravarty:** Will the Minister of Education and Scientific Research be pleased to refer to the reply given to Starred Question No. 1019 on the 18th March, 1958 and state:

(a) the steps taken to declare Jorasanko Calcutta ancestral home of the poet Rabindranath Tagore as a national monument;

(b) whether the Tagore Centenary Celebration Committee has formed any proposals in this regard; and

(c) if not, whether Government have placed any proposals before this Committee?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Education and Scientific Research (Dr. K. L. Shrimall): (a) and (b). The matter is under consideration of the Tagore Centenary Celebration Committee set up by the Sahitya Akademi. It has made a recommendation that the Tagore ancestral house in Calcutta be preserved and maintained as a national memorial by the West Bengal Government.
