- (b) what are the present estimated daily per capita average consumption of milk and milk products in those ·States?

Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

- (b) how much of the said expenditure was for permanent purposes and how much for the temporary purpose of celebrating the occasion?

The Deputy Minister of Ballways (Shri Shah Nawas Ehan): (a) and (b). Only a sum of about Rs. 5,000 was spent on the inauguration ceremeny. This expenditure is for works of temporary nature.

Arecanut Research Station

The Deputy Minister of Food and Agriculture (Shri A. M. Thomas): (a) It is proposed to set up a Regional Arecanut Research Station in Kerala State. No final decision has, however, been taken so far with regard to the location of the station.

Quinino

*89. Shri Raghunath Singh: Will the Minister of Health be pleased to state whether it is a fact that the demand of Quinine is declining and the agriculturists of West Bengal and Madras are suffering due to the import of synthetic anti-malaria drugs?

The Minister of Health (Shri D. P. Karmarkar): Yes, the demand for Quinine is declining. As Cinchons is grown and Quinine is manufactured exclusively as a State enterprise in Madras and West Bengal, the question of suffering by the agriculturists due to the restricted import of synthetic anti-malarials does not arise.
