(a) the progress made so far in the direction of opening of a New Medical College attached to the Irwin Hospital, Delhi;

(b) whether the students will be admitted this year;

(c) if so, how many and whether they will come from Delhi only or from other Union territories also; and

(d) whether there is any proposal to co-ordinate the teaching in the three medical Colleges in Delhi viz. Lady Hardinge Medical College, the All-India Institute of Medical Sciences and the new Medical College attached to the Irwin Hospital?

The Minister of Health (Shri Kar-markar): (a) The College started functioning from the 1st August, 1958.

(b) and (c) 60 students have been admitted this year, of whom 44 belong to Delhi and 11 to other Union Territories, two students belong to Jammu and Kashmir, two are foreign scholars and one student is the ward of a Central Government servant serving in an Indian Mission abroad.

(d) Not at present.
