Pataskar Report

*195. Shri Thanulingam Nadar: Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state the nature of steps taken so far to implement the Pataskar report regarding Madras-Andhra Border?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri Datar): The following steps were taken to implement Shri Pataskar's report on border readjustments between the States of Madras and Andhra Pradesh —

(1) A Committee was appointed by the Southern Zonal Council at its second meeting held at Hyderabad in September 1957 to examine the outstanding issues arising out of the proposed border adjustments

(2) The State Governments were requested in November 1957 to send their proposals regarding the provisions to be made in the bill to be drafted for the purpose. The Government of Madras have sent their proposals recently. The proposals of the Andhra Pradesh Government are awaited.

Steps will be taken to introduce necessary legislation on receipt of proposals from the Andhra Pradesh Government.

Shri Thanulingam Nadar: May I know whether the Bill will be brought during the next Session?

Shri Datar: We have yet to receive, as I have stated, the reply of the Andhra Pradesh Government. Government will then consider this question.

Shri C. E. Pattabhi Raman: In view of the state of suspense in the border areas, will the Government consider to expedite the whole matter?

Shri Datar: The Government are trying their best to expedite it.

Shri Subbiah Ambalam: Has any time limit been set for the reply of the Andhra Pradesh Government?

Shri Datar: It will not be proper to lay down any time limit because they have to consider certain questions.

Shri Nath Pai: The Pataskar formula has given its solution to a very tricky problem. Recently, the two Chief Ministers of Bombay and Mysore also met to solve another problem of the same nature regarding the border of Belgaum. Is the Government considering to apply that formula?

Shri Datar: The question does not arise.

Shri Khadilkar: In view of the fact that persistent demands are made from border areas which are supposed to be in dispute and this formula that was applied for settling disputes between Andhra and Madras has settled it amicably, is Government considering that on the same basis all the border disputes should be settled and the sense of discrimination that is prevailing should be removed?

Mr. Speaker: It does not arise out of this question.
