भी अपस वर्तन : अंभी अपन्न विनों दिस्ती थीं एक प्रकार से जलमान ही गंधी थीं, कंसका एक मुख्य कारण यह बतलाया खाता है कि यहां को सीचंचे सिस्टर्ग प्रसम्भत हीं गंधी था, में जानना चाहता हूं कि प्रसक्त बारे में क्या कोई सांस कार्यवाही की जा रही है भीर क्या जेसे वारे में कोई शीधता की जायेगी ?

Shri Karmarkar: I am afraid, Sir, my hon. friend is mistaking drainage for sewerage. Surface drainage of rainfall water is one thing. He is asking about that, whereas what I am telling him here about the sewerage system.

Supply of Foodgrains to U.P.

\*1501. { Shri S. M. Banerjee: Shri Tangamani:

Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

(a) whether a request was made by the Government of Uttar Pradesh for allowing supply of foodgrains to U.P. from Punjab and withdrawal of zonal restrictions; and

(b) if so, the steps taken by Centre in this direction?

The Deputy Minister of Agriculture (Shri M. V. Krishnappa): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir, a request was made by the U.P. Government for the withdrawal of the existing zonal restriction on the movement of wheat from Punjab to U.P., but it could not be accepted.

Shri S. M. Banerjee: May I know the quantity of foodstuffs supplied to U.P. for September and October, and whether this quantity will be sufficient to meet their requirements?

The Minister of Food and Agriculture (Shri A. P. Jain): I have repeated these figures many times in the House. For the month of September we are supplying 85,000 tons of foodgrains; about October, we have not yet fixed the quantity which we are going to supply.

Shri S. M. Bandifee: May I know whether the Central Government have issued instructions to the U.P. Government to apply rigidly the previsions of the Essential Commodities Act; and, if so, whether this has been done by the State Government, and with what results?

Shri A. P. Jain: The U.P. Government asked for certain powers. There was no question of our giving any instruction. Those powers have been given and some action has been taken. The action is being reported in the papers from day to day.

Shri Tangameni: May I know whether this matter was discussed with Government when the Chief Minister of U.P. was here last week?

Shri A. P. Jain: Which matter?

Shri Tangamani: This particular matter about releasing grains from the zonal restrictions.

Shri A. P. Jain: No, this matter was not discussed because this had been decided before.

Shri C. D. Pande: May I know if the Government will consider the advisability of releasing at least wheat seeds for U.P., because no wheat seeds are available there?

Shri A. P. Jain: We have already agreed to do that, and the office of the U.P. Government is in touch with the Punjab Government for the transport of seeds.

श्री स्वाराण तिहु: श्या मंत्री महोदल यह बतलाने की कुपा करेंगे कि जो गत्सा केन्द्र से उत्तर प्रदेश को मेजा जा रहा है उसका कुछ हिस्सा देहालों में भी बांडने के लिये रक्खा है भीर क्या उन्हें यह पता है कि उत्तर प्रदेश के देहालों में सभी भी गत्सा प्राप्य नहीं है भीर जो प्राप्य है भी वह बहुत तेज भाव पर है ?

भी स० प्र० भीन : को सनाज उत्तर प्रदेश को दिया जा रहा है उसमें से काफी तादाद देहातों में कांटी जा नहीं है।

Shri S. M. Banerjee: May I know whether the prices of foodstuffs have come down in U.P.; if so, to what extent?

Shri A. P. Jain: The prices of foodstuffs have, generally, come down in U.P. The price of wheat has gone down, roughly speaking, by Rs. 2; the price of rice has gone down in some places by as much as Rs. 6 to Rs. 8, in other places by Rs. 4 and still less in certain other places. The prices of coarse grains have also gone down.

भी प्रकास बीर झास्त्री: क्या मंत्री महोदय यह बतलाने की क्रुपा करेंगे कि जो केन्द्र से उत्तर प्रदेश को प्रनाज मेजा जा रहा है, उसके सम्बन्ध में उत्तर प्रदेश शासन को इस प्रकार की हिदायतें दी गई हैं कि बाद पीड़ित क्षेत्रों को उसमें प्राथमिकता दी कार्य ?

भी घ० प्रश्नेत: जी हां, बाद पीड़ित क्षेत्रों में भी वहां से दिया जा रहा है।

भी प्रकाश बीर शास्त्री: में जानना जाहता हूं कि क्या मंत्री महोक्य के पास इस किस्म की कोई रिपोर्ट धाई है कि उत्तर प्रदेश शासन की भोर से जो सस्ते गल्ले की दुकानें कोसी गई है उनमें बाढ़ पीड़ित क्षेत्रों के वास्ते ज्यान रक्का गया है?

भी भं प्र० चैन : ऐसी बात है।

वी सिह्तसम सिह : बाढ़ पीड़ित क्षेत्रों में सस्ते गल्ले की दुकानों पर जो गल्ले की निकबार की, क्या जसको बढ़ा विभा गया है और भगर बढ़ा विमा क्या है सो कितना बढ़ाया गया है ?

भी घ० प्र० वैन : बाद तो प्रभी माई थी भीर प्रभी ही दुकार्ने खुकी हैं इससियें उनमें घटाने बढ़ाने का भेरे प्रन्थाज से तो कोई सवास नहीं है और दूसरे यह ऐसी तफसील की बातें हैं जिनको कि उत्तर प्रवेश गवर्नेमेंट खुद करती है।

Export of Foodgrains from Rajasthan

Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

- (a) what is the quantity of foodgrains which has been moved out from Rajasthan during the last six months;
- (b) what is the quantity of foodgrains sent to Rajasthan to meet the food situation;
- (c) the reasons as to why Bombay City has been included in this zone; and
- (d) what is the quantity of food required for the city and moved for the city from Rajasthan?

The Deputy Minister of Agriculture (Shri M. V. Krishnappa): (a) Figures of movement of the different kinds of foodgrains of trade account are not readily available.

- (b) 14,200 tons of imported wheat have been supplied from Central stocks during the year upto the September, 1958.
- (c) and (d). Although Bombay City was initially excluded from the Western Wheat Zone, it rightly belongs to this zone. The restriction on movement to Bombay City from the rest of the zone was removed in order to allow the people in Bombay City to purchase some indigenous wheat
