ORAL ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS

Flying Club in Jammu and Kashmir

*890. Shri A. M. Tariq: Will the Minister of Transport and Communications be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal to establish a flying club in Jammu and Kashmir State; and

(b) if not, whether the Government would consider the establishment of such a club as soon as possible?

The Deputy Minister of Civil Aviation (Shri Mohiuddin): (a) No, Sir.

(b) The establishment of a Flying Club rests with the local residents or the State Government concerned. The Government of India can extend the subsidy scheme to a flying club in Jammu and Kashmir if one is established.
