- (c) The decision is that the Government of Orissa will procure rice and paddy on behalf of the Central Government at prices fixed by the Government of India and the Central Government will take delivery of such rice and paddy from the purchasing agents of the State Government after inspection of quality The Central Government will advance funds from time to time to the State Government to enable them to make payments to their purchasing agents and such payments will be made by the State Government on the basis of quality assessment of rice and paddy made by the Central Government Officers in Orissa with reference to the prescribed specifications
- (d) Yes, the Central Government have set up an organization in Orissa for quality inspection of rice and paddy and for taking delivery of the foodgrams procured in the State.
