World Bank Loan

*1399. **Shri Ram Krishan Gupta:** Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to refer to the reply given to Starred Question No. 331 on the 26th November, 1959 and state:

(a) whether World Bank has granted loan to the Industrial Finance Corporation; and

(b) if so, the amount thereof?

The Deputy Minister of Finance (Shri B. E. Bhagat): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

Shri Ram Krishan Gupta: What is the amount of loan for which the IFC has applied to the World Bank?

Shri B. E. Bhagat: Actually, the IFC has not applied. The Government a couple of years ago took up the question of loan credit with the 152 (A) L.S.D- i.

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World Bank for an amount of 10 million dollars but that was not pursued later on.

Shri S. M. Banerjee: In reply to a previous Question, "Whether the Industrial Finance Corporation applied to the World Bank for loan", the reply given was, "Yes, but the proposal was not finalised". want to know when the proposal is going to be finalised.

Shri B. E. Bhagat: As I said, it was not pursued.

The Minister of Education (Dr. K. L. Shrimall): (a) Yes Sir.

(b) The projectors will be sold to Central State Governments (including institutions run directly by them) at the wholesale rate, viz. Rs. 325/- per unit, with a Strip film carrier and Rs. 300/- per unit without it.
