(d) Only eight out of twenty four two-roomed flats are allotable because the net cost is less than Rs. 10,000 after allowing rebate for half end walls.

(d) It has been reported that in the process of removing the Surplus earth at the site of the new National Museum Building on Janpath a mass of earth about 75 cft. in volume from a partly dismantled mound slipped and fell on the workers and resulted in the unfortunate casualties.
