The Deputy Minister of Finance (Shrimati Tarkeshwari Sinha): The Film Finance Corporation has since been set up and the Board of Directors constituted. The authorised Capital of the Corporation is Rs. 1 crore of which Rs. 20 lakhs, wholly subscribed by Government, is the initial issued Capital.

Iron Ore and Limestone Deposits in Jammu

*114. Shri P. C. Borooah:

Will the Minister of Steel, Mines and Fuel be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that deposits of iron ore and limestone have been found near the Kalakot coal mines about 80 miles from Jammu; and
 - (b) if so, the details thereof

The Minister of Steel, Mines and Fuel (Sardar Swaran Singh): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The iron ore deposits were located in the Pauni-Barakh Metah and Kandali areas. The approximate iron are deposits in the Kandali area are of the order of 5 million tons. Recent investigation undertaken by the Geological Survey of India in Kandali area during 1959-60 have not been promising as the ore bodies are irregular.

It has been reported by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir that a limestone band of appreciable thickness has been found in the vicinity of Kalakot. The Department of Geology and Mining, Government of Jammu and Kashmir propose to investigate it in detail shortly.
