दिल्ली में नेताओं की मूर्तियां स्थापित करना

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थी प्रकाशवीर शास्त्री : श्री म० ला० द्विवेदी : श्री राम इष्ठण गुप्त : श्री रामेश्वर टांटिया : सरदार इकबाल सिंह :

क्या **गृह-कार्य** मंत्री यह बताने की इत्या करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या सरदार पटेल, नेताजी सुभाष चन्द्र बोस श्रौर स्वामो श्रद्धानन्द की मूर्त्तियां स्थापित करने के लिये स्थान चुन लिये गये हैं;

(ख) क्या यह सच है कि दिल्ली मे अन्य स्थानों पर जहां से विदेशियों को मूर्तियाँ इटाई जावेंगो, पंडित मदन मोहन मालवीय और लाला लाजपत राय की मूर्तियाँ स्थापित करने का प्रश्न मी विचारावीन हैं; और

(ग) क्या महाराती लक्ष्मीबाई की मूर्त्ति भी दिल्ली में किसी महत्वपूर्ण स्वान पर स्वापित की जायेगी ?

गूह-कार्य मंत्री (वी गो० व० पन्त) : (क) ग्रीर (ग). सलाहकार समिति ने नेताजो सुभाव चन्द्र बोस, स्वामो श्रद्धा नम्द, लाखा लाजपतराय तथा सहारानी लक्ष्मी बाई की 1030 (Ai) LSD-1. मूर्तियों को सुझावदातार्क्षा (Sponsors) द्वारा सुझाए गए स्थानों पर स्थापित करने की दृष्टि से विचार किया था। परन्तु समिति का ग्रमिमत है कि या तो सुझाए गए स्थान उप-युक्त नहीं थे, या झावक्ष्यक घनराशि प्रत्यर्पित नहीं की गई थी।

सरदार पटेल को मूर्ति की स्थापना **से** सम्बन्धित विस्तरण सुझावदाताय्रों के साथ परामर्शद्वारा तैयार किये जा रहे हैं।

(ख) जिन स्यानों से विदेशियों की मूर्तियाँ हटाई जायेंगो, उन स्थानों पर मूर्तियाँ स्थापित करने का कोई प्रस्ताव इस समय सरकार के विचाराघोन नहीं हैं।

Shri Achar: The English version may also be read.

Shri G. B. Pant: (a) and (c). Proposals for the installation of statues of Netaji Subash Chandra Bose, Swami Shradha Nand, Lala Lajpat Rai and Maharani Laxmi Bai were considered by the Advisory Committee on the installation of statues with reference to the sites suggested by the sponsors. It was, however, found by the Committee that either the sites suggested were not suitable or they were not supported by the offer of necessary finance.

As regards the installation of statue of Sardar Patel, details are being worked out in consultation with the sponsors.

(b) No proposal for installing statues at the places from which statues of foreigners are to be removed is under consideration of Government at present.

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श्वी प्रकाश वीर शास्त्री : क्या यह अ.वस्यक नहीं है कि सरकार इस समिति को यह मुआव दे कि जैसे भी हो नेताजा सुभाष चन्द्र बोस की प्रतिमा लाल िले के सामने और स्वामी श्रद्धानन्द की प्रस्तर प्रतिमा दिल्ली के टाउन हाल के सामने, जहाँ पहले घण्टाघर था, हो स्थापित की जाये, क्योंकि इन दोतों का उन स्थानों पर हुई ऐतिहासिक घटनाओं से सम्बन्ध है ?

श्री गो० व० पन्त : मैं इस सम्बन्ध में पहले भो उत्तर दे चुका हूं प्रौर शायद माननीय सदस्य के ही प्रश्नों का उत्तर दिया हो कि यह प्रक्ष एडवाइजरो कमेटी वर्क्स एण्ड हाउसिंग मिनिस्ट्री से सम्बन्धित है । उन्होंने इन बातों की ग्रब्छो तरह से जांच की ग्रौर देखा कि इन जगहों पर ये मूर्तियाँ, या कोई मूर्तियाँ, स्थापित नहीं हो सकतीं । इसके ग्रलावा जहाँ तक मुझे इत्तिला है, इस्.के बारे में जो कुछ खर्चा होगा, वह दिया जायगा, इस सम्बन्ध में किसो ने उनको इत्सिनान भी नहीं दिलाया है ।

Maharajkumar Vijaya Anand: In view of Tagore and Motilal Centenary next May, is there any proposal to instal their statues in Delhi?

Shri G B. Pant: There is, I understand, a proposal for installing the statue of Pandit Motilal Nehru in the neighbourhood of Parliament House.

Maharajkumar Vijaya Anand: Would the statue of Tagore also be installed.

Shri G. B. Pant: I am not aware of that. I am told that that question is under consideration.

श्वी भक्त दर्शन : माननीय गृह मंत्री जी ने ग्रभी बताया हूँ कि विदेशी शासकों की मूर्तियों को हटाने के बाद उन स्था गें पर किन की मूर्तियां स्थापित की जायें, यह प्रश्न ग्रभी सरकार के विचाराधीन नहीं हैं। मैं यह जानना चाहता हूं कि क्या उन को हटाने के बाद वे स्थान खाली रखे जायें या उनकी पूर्ति ग्रवश्य की जायगी। श्रीगो० ब० पन्त : जहाँ कोई दूसरी चीज रखी जायगो, वह जगह तो खाली नहीं रहेगी श्रीर अहाँ कोई चीज नहीं रखी जायगी, वहाँ कोई मुर्ति नहीं होगी।

Shri Ranga: Are there no proposals for installing the statues of Mahatma Gandhi and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel?

Shri Tyagi: No.

Shri Ranga: Is it not possible for the Home Ministry itself to take the initiative in this direction and do something?

Shri G. B. Pant: So far as the Home Ministry is concerned, the matter has not been placed before it and no particular consideration has been given to it.

Shri Ranga: Is it not possible?

Mr. Speaker: He wants to know why the Home Ministry is not considering the matter suo motu.

Shri G. B. Pant: Because it does not come within the usual scope, functions and duties of the Home Ministry.

Shri Ram Krishan Gupta: In view of the reply given just now by the hon. Home Minister, may I know whether Government will try to find out alternative sites for the installation of these statues?

Shri G. B. Pant: If suggestions are made in a proper form and the conditions which have been prescribed for this purpose are satisfied, that is, an offer of the finances that will be involved in the matter, I think, the Advisory Committee will give thought to the question.

Shri Tyagi: Just to avoid misunderstanding being created in the country, may I ask a question? The hon. Home Minister just now announced that the statue of Pandit Motilal Nehru is being considered to be installed here in the vicinity of Parliament House. I wonder if the payment for that has been made by any particular party. Or, isthat also a Government decision?

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An Hon. Member: Why not for Subhas Bose?

Shri Tyagi: When Mahatma Gandhi's and Sardar Patel's statues could not be decided upon for want of money or something I wonder how this one statue has been decided upon.

Shri G. B. Pant: The statue of Pandit Motilal Nehru is to be installed at the cost of or out of the contribution made by the Motilal Nehru Centenary Committee which is collecting funds and is also taking other steps for the celebration of the Centenary. The Government is not spending anything over it.

Shri Tyagi: If the other memorial committees decide to make a contribution for the other statues perhaps they might also be installed, including Mahatma Gandhi's.

Shri G. B. Pant: About Mahatma Gandhi's statue I do not know if some place has not already been selected. But this matter is not directly under my Ministry. We have to get the approval of the WHS Ministry which is concerned with this. But I will make enquiries about this. About Sardar Patel's statue, the cost of the statue is to be paid by some persons who have sponsored it.

Shri Tyagi: Is that statue coming up?

Shri G. B. Pant: Yes.

Shri Tyagi: Let that be clear. That is what I wanted to know.

Shri G. B. Pant: It is clear. It will be installed at Vijay Chowk and it will be a big statue, I hope. I have stated that previously too.

Shri Indrajit Gupta: May I know approximately how long it will take to remove these statues of foreigners in Delhi, particularly the statues of former King Emperors? What is proposed to be done with the statues that are removed?

Shri G. B. Pant: I think that that matter too has come up before this House a number of times and it has been stated that when suitable accommodation is available in a museum or other suitable place, then such statues as are desired to be removed will be removed.

Shri Achar: May I know who are the members of the Committee which decides upon the selection and other things?

Shri G. B. Pant: I think I have given the names of the members some time previously. I have not got their names before me. I think it is mostly an expert committee.
