Research Scholarships for Sanskrit

*769. Shri Jhulan Sinha: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state the position as it obtains now regarding the scheme for grant of research scholarships to the products of traditional Sanskrit Pathshalas?

The Minister of Education (Dr. K. L. Shrimali): The Central Sanskrit Board has recommended some candidates for award of the scholarships and the names of those selected will be announced shortly.

Passengers from Ceylon

*770. Shri Subbiah Ambalam: Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have reduced the value of goods permitted to be brought by passengers coming from Ceylon to India;
- (b) if so, the value of the goods permitted;
- (c) whether representations have been received from the Ceylon Chettiar Chamber of Commerce regarding the harassment caused to passengers by the Customs authorities: and
- (d) if so, the steps proposed to be taken to remove such harassment.

The Deputy Minister of Finance (Shri B. R. Bhagat): (a) and (b). The value of goods permitted to be imported duty free as passengers' baggage has not been reduced. However. under a misinterpretation of the Import Trade Control Public Notice No. 83 dated the 15th October, 1958, which did not apply to Ceylon, even passengers from Ceylon were being granted further concession of clearing Rs. 500 worth of goods on payment of duty but without an Import Trade Control Licence, if they had stayed out of India continuously for more than six months. This mistake has been rectified and the concession stopped since September, 1960.

Off Survey in Brahmaputra Valley

*771. Shri P. C. Boroosh: Will the Minister of Steel, Mines and Fact be pleased to state:

- (a) how many oil wells the Oil India Private Ltd., has drilled up till now in the Brahmaputra Vallely;
- (b) how many of them have proved to be successful;
- (c) whether they have found any gas wells; and
- (d) what is the general progress of the drilling operations?

The Minister of Mines and Oil (Shri K. D. Malaviya): (a) 86 wells.

- (b) and (c). 68 wells are successful of which 7 are gas wells. Besides 6 wells are awaiting further testing.
