- (b) and (c). As only certain elaborate types of rural water supply schemes are proposed to be taken up under the National Water Supply and Sanitation Programme, there will be limited provision under the 'Health' Plan. In this connection attention is also invited to paras 39—41 of Chapter Vi of the Draft Outline of the Third Five Year Plan.
- (d) About Rs. 50—55 crores are likely to be available for rural water supply schemes under the various programmes in the Third Five Year Plan.
