ORAL ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS

Central Industrial Extension Training Institute

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*1098. { Shri Shree Narayan Das:
Shri Radha Raman:

Will the Minister of Commerce and
Industry be pleased to state:

(a) the progress made in the direction of the establishment of a Central Industrial Extension Training Institute for which the Ford Foundation has sanctioned some grant;

(b) the total cost involved and the amount sanctioned by the Foundation;

(c) the precise scope and function of the Institute?

The Minister of Industry (Shri Manubhai Shah): (a) to (c). A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT

(a) Suitable buildings for temporarily housing the Central Industrial Extension Training Institute at Hyderabad have been selected and the State Government have been requested to acquire and place them at the disposal of the Government of India.

The Principal of the Institute has been appointed and action is in hand
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to recruit the necessary staff—both Indian and foreign.

The first course in the Institute is expected to start in the beginning of January, 1962.

(b) The scheme is financed jointly by the Government of India and the Ford Foundation. The Government of India contribution is estimated to be about Rs. 2 lakhs a year. The sanctioned budget allocation for the year 1961-62 is Rs. 2,85,000. The Ford Foundation have sanctioned a grant of \$600,000 for the first five years.

(c) The main functions of the Institute are:—

- (i) to improve the Extension Services including training of staff of the Central Small Scale Industries Organisation and the Industries Departments of State Governments for the development of small scale industries;
- (ii) to undertake studies on subject matter, teaching methods and communication materials required for the development of small scale industries and to maintain contacts with organisations conducting similar studies in India and abroad.

Shri Radha Raman: May I know the number of persons who will be recruited for this training and the method of recruitment?

Shri Manubhai Shah: There will be four or five foreign technicians under the Ford Foundation grants, and four or five directors as counter-studies or under-studies under the foreign experts. They will be recruited like all other technical officers

through a proper advertisement and by a proper selection board.

Shri Radha Raman: May I know whether the States will also participate in meeting a part of the expenditure or not?

Shri Manubhai Shah: There will be about 80 officers annually to be re-oriented in this programme which also will include the nominees of the State Governments, and they will participate only to the extent of bearing the expenses of such trainees on their behalf.

Shri Radha Raman: May I know whether, in the matter of recruitment of such officers as will get training here, the Government have any plan for recruiting them regional-wise or State-wise or whether it will be from a common centre?

Shri Manubhai Shah: It will be State-wise or region-wise.

Shri Radha Raman: May I know their number?

Shri Manubhai Shah: It would be 40 per half year and 80 for a full year.

Shri Nagi Reddy: May I know the remuneration that will be paid to the foreign technicians that are taking part in this?

Shri Manubhai Shah: That will be against the Ford Foundation grants, and we will know it only when the appointment is made by them.

श्री म० सा० द्विवेदी : मैं जानना चाहता हूँ कि इस इंस्टिट्यूट के लिये जो अधिकारी भरती किये जायेंगे उन के लिये क्या नियम रक्खे जायेंगे क्या वे स्टेटवाइज भरती किये जायेंगे या सारे देश में योग्यता के आधार पर लिये जायेंगे ?

श्री मनुभाई साहू : जैसा मैंने बतलाया, वे स्टेटवाइज लिये जायेंगे। उन को इस सम्बन्ध में कुछ कड़ी योग्यता दिखलानी होगी। जो इसमें काबिल समझे जायेंगे उन्हीं को लिया जायेगा।

Dr. Sushila Nayar: May I know where this institute will be located? Secondly, may I know whether the Ford Foundation experts will levy the expenditure on the same basis as for other foreign experts, namely, our paying the internal expenses and salaries, etc., and their paying the rest, or whether the Ford Foundation will bear the total expenditure on this score?

Shri Manubhai Shah: The institute will be located at Hyderabad. The Ford Foundation will pay the foreign expenses, and as the hon. lady Member has rightly pointed out, the Indian costs will be borne by us.

Dr. Sushila Nayar: How much will be the Indian cost?

Shri Manubhai Shah: That is given in the statement. Rs. 2 lakhs a year will be the contribution from the Central Government towards the expenses of the staff and various other matters.

Shri Nagi Reddy: What is the contribution of the Ford Foundation to this institute?

Shri Manubhai Shah: Rs. 30 lakhs is the total, which will include expenditure on the experts plus equipment and various other things.

Shri Nagi Reddy: What is the total expenditure that is going to be incurred on this institute other than the grant that is now being offered by the Ford Foundation?

Shri Manubhai Shah: This will be quite an additional grant. The Ford Foundation's commitments are very widespread; they have certain things in the Ministry of Education, Ministry of Scientific Research and Cultural Affairs, and so on.

Mr. Speaker: What exactly will be the additional expenditure?

Shri Manubhai Shah: Rs. 30 lakhs will be the additional expenditure.

Shri Nagi Reddy: I want to know the amount on our side.

Shri Manubhai Shah: On our side, it is Rs. 2 lakhs a year plus certain Indian costs which will be borne from year to year.

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of External Affairs (Shri Sadath Ali Khan): (a) and (b). Yes, Sir, such reports have appeared in the Pakistan Press.

(c) Sir, the attention of the Honourable Member is drawn to Government's answer to unstarred question No. 1033 on November 30, 1960 in the Lok Sabha on this subject.

श्री प्रकाशवीर शास्त्री : ३० नवम्बर, मन् १९६० को इस प्रश्न का उत्तर दिया गया था उसमें कहा गया था कि हिन्दुस्तान की ओर से सुरक्षा परिषद में कोई विरोध पत्र नहीं भेजा गया, और अभी, जैसा माननीय सभा सचिव जी ने बतलाया, उसका निर्माण कार्य जारी है। तो क्या कारण है कि इस बीच में सुरक्षा परिषद से विरोध नहीं प्रकट किया गया ?

श्री सादत अली खान : तीन बार हमने इस मामले में सिक्योरिटी कोमिस के सामने

प्रोटैस्ट किया है, और हमारी यह सारी प्रोटैस्ट्स यूनाइटेड नेशन्स के जो दूसरे मेम्बर्स वहाँ पर थे उनके पास सर्कुलेट हुई। इससे ज्यादा तो कोई ऐसी बात हमें मालूम नहीं है जिस पर गौर किया जाय।

(تمن ہمارے نے اس معاملہ میں سیکورٹی کونسل کے سامنے پروٹیسٹ کیا ہے۔ اور ہماری یہ ساری پروٹیسٹس یونائیٹڈ نیشن کے جو دوسرے ممبرس وہاں پر تھے ان کے پاس سرکولایٹ ہوئیں اس سے زیادہ کوئی ایسی بات ہمیں معلوم نہیں ہے جس پر غور کیا جائے)۔

श्री प्रकाशवीर शास्त्री : क्या मे जान सकता हूँ कि भारत सरकार सुरक्षा परिषद् को विरोध पत्र भेजने भेजते इतनी थक गई है कि अब कोई और विरोध पत्र नहीं भेजना चाहती है ? और यदि नहीं भेजना चाहती है, तो क्यों ?

श्री सादत अली खान : यकने का सवाल नहीं है। सारा काम जो पाकिस्तान की तरफ से हो रहा है वह इस्लीगन है, और पोजीशन यह है कि वह टेरिस्टी हमारी है। हम उसे हार्मिल करेगे मुल्क में, धमन में। वहाँ जो कुछ बह कर रहे हैं अब तक वह सब गलत कर रहे हैं।
