The question of taking action on the resolution, therefore, does not arise.

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of External Affairs (Shri Sadath Ali Khan): (a) to (c). Certain limited items of expenditure in connection with the Belgrade Conference, mainly on interpreter and shorthand services and the hiring of equipment for simultaneous interpretation, are

to be met jointly by the participating countries, excepting Algeria and Congo. The share of each participating country is to be determined according to the proportion of their respective contributions to the United Nations. On this basis, India's actual share worked out to about 49.7 per cent, but it was decided at a meeting of officials held prior to the Conference that India's share should be limited to 25 per cent of the divisible expenditure. This amount has not yet been worked out and has, therefore, still to be paid.
