

(b) Two storage tanks of 15,000 Kilo Litres capacity are already in operation. Additional capacity is under construction.

(c) Normally, Kandla Installation would feed the following areas in respect of all products:—

- (i) The metre gauge section of part of Gujerat.
- (ii) The metre gauge section of Rajasthan (with N. Railway and W. Railway).
- (iii) The whole of Punjab including B. G. Stations which are fed after transshipment at Hissar and Shakurbasti.
- (iv) Part of U. P. including B. G. Section which is fed after transshipment at Shakurbasti.

#### University at Indore

(a) whether University Grants Commission has received any proposal from the Madhya Pradesh Government for the establishment of a University at Indore during the Third Five Year Plan period;

(b) if so, at what stage is the consideration of the proposal by the University Grants Commission; and

(c) by what time a final decision in this regard is expected to be taken?

**The Minister of Education (Dr. K. L. Shrimali):** (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Commission has decided to refer the proposal to the Committee proposed to be appointed by it, to prepare a broad outline plan for new Universities under the Third Five-Year Plan.

(c) It is not possible to indicate a time-limit for a final decision on this proposal.

maintained, but applied on a State basis with reference to assembly elections as well as parliamentary elections.

(b) This question was discussed by the Election Commission with the representatives of political parties at a conference and their views taken into account.
