## **Durgapur Steel Plant**

Will the Minister of Steel, Mines and Fuel be pleased to state:

(a) the steps Government have taken to supply lime-stone flux to Durgapur Steel Plant;

(b) whether it is available in any nearby district of West Bengal; and

(c) if so, whether any arrangement has been made by Government to utilise it?

The Minister of Steel, Mines and •Fuel (Sardar Swaran Singh): (a) During the first few years of production lime-stone will be supplied to the Durgapur Steel Project from Birmitrapur and Hathibari in Orissa. Investigations to locate lime-stone in some nearer sources of supply have been undertaken.

(b) and (c). It has been recently reported that the Government of West Bengal have located deposits of limestone in Purulia District. It appears that lime-stone available from these deposits may not be suitable for fluxing purposes.

The Deputy Minister of Home Affairs (Shrimati Alva): (a) and (b). The view of the Government of India in the communicated to the matter was States in a circular letter addressed to them in May last. This letter Was on the lines that have already been stated more than once on the floor of the House namely that while the members of scheduled castes after conversion to Buddhism are not entitled to the facilities provided under the Constitution specified for scheduled castes but so long as the converts are educationally and economically backward, the same concessions as are normally available to other backward classes should also be available to them.
