Tile: Regarding alleged irregularity in appointment to the post of Secretary, National Medical Commission -laid.

DR. KALANIDHI VEERASWAMY (CHENNAI NORTH): Post graduate medical qualification is one of the mandatory requirements for the post of Secretary, National Medical Commission. However, it has come to my knowledge that a former Secretary, National Medical Commission had allegedly submitted fake post graduate medical degree at the time of his appointment to the post of Secretary, National Medical Commission. In fact, a number of complaints had been made in the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India in relation to fake post graduate medical degree of the former Secretary, National Medical Commission but no action has been taken against him so far. Unofficial enquires with the concerned university have also confirmed that he has not been awarded any P.G. degree from the college.

I, therefore, request the Government to kindly look into the matter and if it is found correct, also request you to take stringent action against him.
