Title: Request to instruct the authorities to make a review on the construction of AIIMS in Yadadri Bhongir District, Bhongir Parliamentary Constituency, Telengana and to issue a clear title and a blueprint to AIIMS to proceed further and to complete the pending construction.

SHRI KOMATI REDDY VENKAT REDDY (BHONGIR): Hon. Chairperson, Madam, thank you for giving me an opportunity to speak today.

I would like to bring to your kind notice that the AIIMS hospital is going to be constructed at Bibinagar in Yadadri Bhongir District, which falls in my Bhongir Parliamentary Constituency in Telangana State.

For this purpose, an MoU was entered into between the State Government concerned and the Union Government in 2017-18. In the said agreement, the Government of Telangana stated that after acquiring 210 acres of land for this purpose, the same will be allotted to AIIMS. But there is no proper blueprint and also no clear title is given for the same. It is also stated that if the clearance certificate is available with AIIMS, they will construct the pending part of the building. The Central Government has already released funds to construct the AIIMS building, but under the circumstances, the construction work of AIIMS has not been proceeded further. Moreover, in AIIMS campus, out of sixteen lifts, only three lifts are working. The lifts have already been structured, but have not been constructed fully, which is causing a lot of inconvenience to the people and especially to the patients.

Apart from that, there are high tension electricity wires which are running via AIIMS compound, due to which people are facing many problems. These types of hazardous wires are not suitable for hospital premises as they pose a great danger to the lives of the public.

Therefore, I request the hon. Minister of Health to kindly intervene in the matter and instruct the authorities of the State Government concerned to make a review on the construction of AIIMS building properly and to issue a clear title and a blueprint to AIIMS to proceed further and to complete the pending construction without any further delay, which is very useful for the people.
