In the
absence
of any
recognition
of our
religion,
our
population
estimation
is not
accurate,
which is
a matter
of serious
concern.
I would
like to
draw
your
attention
towards
the fact
that
communities
with
population
smaller
than
those of
the tribal
groups
enjoy
separate
religious
identity.
Sarna
Code is
very
important
for tribal
communities
and there
is a need
for
recognition
for
recognition
of this
separate
identity
which is
very
much
essential.
Hence,
for the
larger
interest
of the
tribe
population
of the
entire
country, I
urge
upon the
Union
Government
to
approve
'Sarna
Code for
the
Census
2021, so
that it
will have
a
separate
column
for the
Tribal
community,
allowing
members
of these
communities
to
identify
themselves
as
belonging
to a
distinct
religious
community.
