Title: Regarding separate religion code for tribal population in Census 2021-laid.

KUMAR HANSDAK (RAJMAHAL): On November 11 2020, the Jharkhand Assembly, in a special session passed a resolution asking for a separate religion code for the tribal population in Census 2021 and sent it to the Centre for approval The

naming of this code in the resolution is 'Sarna Adivasi Dharam'. The main purpose of this resolution is the recognition of the tribal identity in India. The followers of 'Sarna' are usually nature worshippers. The Constitution has a

separate schedule, Fifth Schedule for the tribal population. Then why our religion has not yet been recognised? In the absence of any recognition of our religion, our population estimation is not accurate, which is a matter of serious concern. I would

like to draw your attention towards the fact that communities with population smaller than those of the tribal groups enjoy separate religious identity. Sarna Code is very important for tribal communities and there is a need for recognition

of this separate identity which is very much essential. Hence, for the larger interest of the tribe population of the entire country, I urge upon the Union Government to approve 'Sarna Code for the Census 2021, so that it

will have а separate column for the Tribal community, allowing members of these communities to identify themselves as belonging to a distinct religious community.
