Title: Regarding crimes against women in Jharkhand -laid.

SHRI JAYANT SINHA (HAZARIBAGH): The number of cases of crimes against women has been persistently increasing in the state of Jharkhand, making this issue a matter of urgent concern. Recent media reports suggest that in the first 213 days of the year 2020, 1033 cases of rape, 161 cases of dowry deaths, and 16 cases related to witch-hunting were reported.
