Title: Regarding Indian students pursuing medical courses in China -laid.

SHRI N. K. PREMACHANDRAN (KOLLAM): The students from India undergoing MBBS courses in various universities of China are in trouble due to restrictions imposed by Chinese Government. The Indian students studying in China have returned to India due to spread of COVID-19. Now, the Chinese universities reopened the medical colleges and resuming their courses. The Chinese Government has permitted students from foreign countries to join their colleges and visa and travel facilities were provided. The Indian students have repeatedly requested the authorities to permit them to join their MBBS course in China along with other students. The diplomatic efforts, if any, made by the Government may kindly be elaborated. However, it seems that there is no progress in the matter. The situation calls for immediate action. The future of Indian students studying in Chinese medical colleges is in crisis.
