Title: Need to address the problems being faced by Ambulance workers in the country- Laid

SHRI M. K. RAGHAVAN (KOZHIKODE): Ambulance workers across the country have immense problems than we understand. A concerted view to address their genuine problems have never been attempted by any authority. The prevalence of post-traumatic stress, symptom and mental health problems, largest mortality rate among ambulance workers, lack of financial reward are some of the major areas which needs to be studied for their welfare. Ambulance workers face different challenges in urban and rural areas. No comparative study has been done between ambulance workers and the normative working population.

It is requested that the Govt should consider to undertake a study on their work culture and welfare measures including ESI, Insurance, and Pension could be extended to them.
