Title: Regarding relaying of sewage and water pipelines in North Chennai -laid.

DR. KALANIDHI VEERASWAMY (CHENNAI NORTH): North Chennai is one of the oldest (more than 150 years) and most historic parts of the city. The infrastructure of sewage and water lines have got damaged over time. Sewage water getting mixed with potable drinking water has become a common problem in few localities of North Chennai, making public of these localities susceptible to waterborne infections. The situation has put many residents in a tough spot, as they are now buying water for drinking and other purposes. People belonging to lower economic groups are using the water, as they cannot afford to buy canned water. Multiple complaints have been made to the local authorities in this regard but the issues have not been fully solved as yet.

As it involves huge costs, I request Centre and State Governments to provide fund for relaying of sewage and water lines in North Chennai or through any Central Government Scheme to help the poor people of my Parliamentary Constituency.
