SHRI NITESH GANGA DEB (SAMBALPUR): People of my Parliamentary Constituency Sambalpur in the State of Odisha have been deprived of qualitative medical facilities and treatment in the absence of AIIMS like institute at Sambalpur. The AIIMS of the state of Odisha was established in the year 2012 at the state capital Bhubaneswar.
