Title: Regarding the issue of setting up of Commission for the scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes by State Government of West Bengal.

SHRI SUDIP BANDYOPADHYAY (KOLKATA UTTAR): Sir, I support the GST issue. Today I want to draw your attention to a very serious issue. The Commissions for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes have been set up in 12 States of the country. Sir, we strongly protest this heinous attitude of the present... \* We will request the hon. Home Minister to intervene and see that the... \* should not disturb the functioning of a State Government. It is an elected State Government. The policy of federal structure is going to be challenged. The Assembly had to close down yesterday only after four days it was in Session. So, it is becoming very serious and very unconstitutional.
