Title: Request to Railway Minister to take back the price hike of Metro tickets in Kolkata.

SHRIMATI MALA ROY (KOLKATA DAKSHIN): Hon. Speaker, Sir, Kolkata Metro Rail Corporation governed by the Railway board has increased the fare prices by Rs. 5 for all stages except the first twokilometre journey, thereby causing financial burden on 6.5 lakh passengers on daily basis, particularly lakhs of common people who come from low income groups, students, unemployed youth and retired senior citizens.
