Title: Need to declare 'Kaleshwaram' Irrigation Project in Telangana as National Project and provide Rs. 20,000 crore as financial assistance

*SHRI DAYAKAR PASUNOORI (WARANGAL): Hon. Speaker Sir, in Telangana 70% of population depends on agriculture for livelihood. Telangana is home for one of the most fertile lands in our country. Farming is pre dominantly dependent on wells, tube wells and ponds. All these sources of water dried up as de-silting was never done. Through Mission Kakatiya around 9500 lakes and wells were desilted and replenished.
