Title: Regarding opening of Jawahar Navodaya Schools in Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency, Telangana-laid.

Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency of Telangana State, is one of the very backward regions in the country. Seven Assembly Segments namely Nagarkurnool, Wanaparthy, Gadwal, Alampur, Achampet, Kawakurthy and Kollapur come under Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency and most of the persons belong to SC/ST, BC and weaker sections of the Society It requires an adequate support from Union Government particularly from the Ministry of Human Resource Development, for the establishment of Jawahar Navodaya Schools, Kendriya Vidyala Schools in this region as most of the students belong to SC/ST, BC and weaker and downtrodden sections of the society. Due to lack of such educational Institutes/colleges/schools like viz., Jawahar Navodaya Schools, Kendriya Vidyala Schools, the students of this region, are facing a lot of difficulties as studying in private schools, colleges would be a costly affair. It would be an ideal condition for such students, if Jawahar Navodaya Schools are established at Alampur and Kalwakurthy now. Keeping in view of the above, I would, therefore, earnestly request the Union Government/Union Minister to kindly accord approval for opening of Jawahar Navodaya Schools at Alampur Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency, Kaiwakurthy, in Telangana so that the students belonging to SC, ST, BC, weaker and downtrodden sections of the society, stand to benefit.
